Their time was precious and had to be used for government purposes, so slaves did most of the physical labor involved with their jobs.

Political geography of ancient Greece in the Archaic and Classical periods Athens suffered a land and agrarian crisis in the late 7th century BC, again resulting in civil strife. The Archon (chief magistrate) Draco made severe reforms to the law code in 621 BC (hence " draconian "), but these failed to quell the conflict.
