Hang your suit out of direct sunlight to dry. Dry the interior first, if you rinsed it, by gently turning it inside out. Lubricate the zipper as specified by the manufacturer. Store the suit gently folded up as recommended by the manufacturer. You can tuck latex seals into the suit arms and body to help protect them.

Below are a few essential skills dry suit divers must learn and practice. All of these are covered in the PADI Dry Suit Diver Specialty course. Venting the drysuit – Most dry suits vent from an exhaust valve on the upper arm, and it takes a bit of practice to learn how to manage, move and efficiently release air. Failing to vent quickly enough can lead to a rapid ascent and serious injury.
