To change gear in a car: Release the accelerator pedal and at the same time press the clutch pedal down. Remove your left hand from the steering wheel, cup it around the gear knob and move the lever gently but positively from one position to another. Return your left hand to the steering wheel.

How To Change Car Gears. Correctly Change Car Gears
When you're driving a manual transmission car and your clutch fails, you can still accelerate and upshift. Upshifting without a clutch isn't a smooth action and is

going to be harsh as your clutch can't be used to ease the transition between gears. Step 1: Accelerate your vehicle to the point of the next gear change. The speed varies from vehicle to vehicle. Upshifting at 3,000-3,500 RPMs is a good range to try.

How to Drive a Manual Transmission Car Without Using the ... Yes you can, however you have to be mindful of your speed. Remember 1st gear is meant to get you rolling, generally in most manuals, you will shift to 2nd at between 10 and 15 mph. So in down shifting you will want to be around that speed as well.
