Wright Mills referred to the sociological perspective as the intersection of biography (the individual) and history (social factors that influence the individual). Sociology is one of several disciplines referred to as a "social science." As the term implies, social sciences address the social world.~~

Conflict theory focuses on the conflict among different racial, ethnic, social class, and other groups and emphasizes how social institutions help ensure inequality.
