The only digestive system function that occurs in the esophagus (moving food into the stomach) Lower Esophageal Sphincters (LES) - Regulates the movement of food from the esophagus into the stomach. Incompetence of the LES results in Gastroesophageal Reflux Disease (GERD), which manifests as "heart burn".
