For larger jobs, rent a heavy-duty right angle drill (\$25 per day) and equip it with a 3/4-inch x 6-inch auger bit (\$7). Electrical house wiring mistakes can be deadly, so make sure you obtain a permit from your local building department and have an electrical rough-in inspection scheduled with a building official when you ' re finished.
