Answer Key for Greenhouse Effect Assessment Questions

What other factors influence the Greenhouse effect? ANSWER - The surface that the radiation first encounters- different surfaces will reflect/absorb different amounts of solar radiation -amount of cloud cover- areas with greater amounts of cloud cover have lower amounts of solar radiation reaching the surface of the Earth and also lower amounts of radiation going back to space.

a gradual increase in air temperatures near Earth's surface. atmospheric heating caused by certain gases in Earth's atmosphere that are transparent to sunlight but absorb and reflect heat that comes from Earth's surface. a gas in Earth's atmosphere that absorbs and then re-radiates heat. the transfer of thermal energy from a warmer object to a cooler object.
