At the end of King Lear, the audience is not clear on who will rule Britain. Lear has died and so have all his heirs. Albany is still the ruler of a portion of Britain, and he asks Edgar and Kent to help him rule. Kent refuses, and his response suggests that he is contemplating suicide: "I have a journey, sir, shortly to go" (V.iii.). Edgar doesn't say whether he'll rule or not, but his response is unenthusiastic: "The weight of this sad time we must obey" (V.iii.).
