In identical spark plug types, the difference from one full heat range to the next is the ability to remove 70 ° C to 100 ° C from the combustion chamber. The heat range numbering system used by spark plug manufacturers is not universal. For example, a 10 heat range in Champion is not the same as a 10 heat range in NGK nor the same in Autolite.
