All MLA in-text citations require the same basic information: Author's last name (no first names or initials) Page number (if available)

When you paraphrase or quote from a source, MLA style requires a citation in-text that will lead your readers to your full Works Cited entry. Often this takes the form of a parenthetical citation at the end of the sentence that includes the authors' last names and the page number where the material you paraphrased or quoted appears.

When deciding how to cite your source, start by consulting the list of core elements. These are the general pieces of information that MLA suggests including in each Works Cited entry. In your citation, the elements should be listed in the following order: Author. Title of source. Title of container, Other contributors, Version, Number, Publisher,

Like a normal conference proceedings, we want to include the name of the entire proceedings, and if there is a specific presentation or paper being cited, include this information as well. We also want to include conference information (name of conference, date, and location) if not already stated in the name of the proceedings.

Include the author's last name in your parenthetical citation. MLA style for in-text citation doesn't vary if you're citing an article that you found online, rather than in print. Start your parenthetical citation with the author's last name. If there are 2 authors, list them both connected by the word "and."

In the body of your paper, use parenthetical documentation (Chapter 5 of MLA Handbook). The purpose of your documentation is for your readers to be able to locate the sources which you cite in your text when they look at your bibliography ("Works Cited") located at the end of your paper.

In MLA style, brief parenthetical citations are inserted in the text to direct the reader to your sources. An MLA in-text citation includes the author's last name and a page number. If a source has two authors, name both. If a source has more than two authors, name only the first author, followed by " et al.

As detailed in the 2016 MLA Handbook, MLA uses a parenthetical documentation system, which means you will place citations in parentheses within your own sentences to indicate you have used ideas, information, and quotations from sources at that particular spot in your paper; the parenthetical information points to specific sources in an alphabetized list of works cited (it's not called a ...
