For many of today's hams there was no choice; obtaining a ham license required learning Morse code. Five words a minute was the requirement for the entry level Novice license and also for the renewable, but VHF only, Technician ticket. A General or Advanced class required 13 wpm and it was 20 wpm for an Extra.

Although amateur radio made up only a small part of the Morse Code usage, it did prepare many hundreds of operators for military duty in communications. In the early 2000s, most countries had dropped the ability to decipher Morse Code from the requirements to obtain an amateur radio licence.

Amateur radio frequency allocation is done by national telecommunication authorities. Globally, the International Telecommunication Union oversees how much radio spectrum is set aside for amateur radio transmissions. In 2003, the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) ratified changes to the Radio Regulations to allow each country to determine whether it would require a person seeking an amateur radio operator license to demonstrate the ability to send and receive Morse code. The effect of this revision was to eliminate the international requirement that a person demonstrate Morse code proficiency in order to qualify for an amateur radio operator license with transmitting privileges on frequencies ...
