The State Board of Professional Engineers and Land
Surveyors (PELS) manages professional engineering
licensing in New Jersey. PELS requires engineers to
complete 24 CPC hours every two years (biennially). At least
2 hours must be in the area of professional practice ethics,
but no more than 8 hours in total may be earned in this
category. Online courses are permissible for license renewal
of professional engineers, with no limit on the amount of
online CPC hours earned.

Continuing Education Requirements for New Jersey Engineers ...

In the State of New Jersey, professional engineers are required to complete 24 professional development hours (PDH). At least two must be in professional practice ethics. For continuing education, there are many options for meeting your requirements.

No. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:8-35 (1)e, the Board's enabling legislation does not contain an eminence or grandfather clause, nor does it provide for reciprocity with any state, territory or country.
