A kitchen range hood should be capable of filtering or circulating all the air in the room once every 4 minutes. That 's entirely circulating the air 15 times in an hour of use. The amount of air range hoods can move is measured in cubic feet per minute, or CFM. The higher the CFM, the faster the air can move.
