Regretful of their past behavior, the sons obey her wish, which is why each time the stream threatens to flood her grave, they sit by the waters and weep. It's also why naughty children in Korea are called "green frogs." Heo (Father's Rubber Shoes?, 1995) provides a gleefully fatalistic retelling, but the writing is surprisingly wooden.

The Korean term for frog is kaeguri, which is also the sound it makes: kaegul, kaegul. When the frog makes its prayer -- its chong -- to Heaven, it does so by crying out its own name. So the name of the frog, chong kaeguri, can be read as either " green frog " or " frog who pleads. "
