Using Solution Folders We use Solution Folders quite a bit to "associate" projects within a Solution. For example, most of our "projects" have 3 actual projects - implementation, unit tests and integration tests. We put all 3 in one Solution Folder. We also might put all Infrastructure in one and all CAB Modules in another.

To create a folder within the solution, right-click the solution name in the Solution Folder and choose "Add", then "New Solution Folder appears, type in a new name.

Files added to mapped folders are automatically copied to the SharePoint hive when the solution is deployed. Files added to a SharePoint project item are deployed to the location that is specified in the Deployment Location property for each file, which is partially set based on the Deployment Type property.

Just use the context menu for the solution and just below the option of creating a new solution folder with the same name as you selected and add the items inside of that folder to the solution folder. This will not move the files on disk.

The Solution Explorer lists files included in the project. In addition to that, files not included in the project but contained in the project folder can be shown using the 'Show All Files' button at the top of Solution Explorer.

Folders Solution folders, sometimes referred to as virtual folders, are a very handy instrument to group your projects. In the Solution Explorer view simply right-click and select Add = > New Solution Folder, then drag-and-drop any of the existing projects to this new folder.
