How many people died in the Vietnam War? There were 1.4 million casualties during the Vietnam War. This number accounts for casualties on both sides of the conflict. Over 2 million soldiers of both sides were wounded in the war but not killed. The United States deployed over 2.5 million soldiers to the Vietnam War and lost 58,220 of those soldiers.
