This means making sure that your paper flows naturally from topic to topic so as to ensure a sense of order. Consistent patterns. If you write your outline in one way, you should stick to it for the whole outline so as to maintain that pattern. General to specific points. Your paper will generally start with general points and make its way to increasingly specific ...
